Sub:- Review of Admission Guidelines - 2009 - reg.

Madam/Sir,

The Board of Governors in its 83<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 26-04-2009 has taken the following decisions:

1. The Admission Guidelines, 2009 shall be kept in abeyance for one year.
2. Admissions for academic session 2009-2010 shall be granted as per Admission Guidelines 2008-09.
3. Wherever the sponsoring authorities have not transferred land to the KV they will provide additional class rooms urgently based on which the required number of sections shall be granted by the KVS.
4. Sponsoring authorities will intimate the KVS in writing well in advance so that additional rooms are constructed in all those campuses where suitable land has been made available by the sponsoring authorities.

In order to facilitate implementation of the Admission Guidelines, 2008 in all the KVs, following instructions should be strictly followed by all the KVs vide KVS letter cited as above.

- a. Efforts should be made to accommodate all Category I children in all the classes wherever vacancies are available as per the class strength prescribed in Para 8 (A) of KVS Admission Guidelines 2008. All the registrations made for various classes should be taken into account while admitting the children as per Admission Guidelines 2008. It must be very clearly understood by all concerned that all the applicants shall have to be considered for unreserved seats ( i.e. total seats minus reserved seats minus the seats reserved for

sponsoring agency as specified under special provisions - 7 (E) and 7 (J). The sponsoring agencies will also be required to follow the same norms being followed for the Central Govt. employees i.e. to accord priority to the ward(s) of transferable employees and among the transferable employees to those have more number of transfers during the previous seven years. Only if any vacancy remains in any class, fresh registration should be started after notifying the vacancies on website of the Region / KV concerned and on the notice board displayed in the KV for the information of the public seeking admission of their ward(s) in the KV. Such publicity should also be done through local newspapers at the regional level requesting the stakeholders to visit RO/ KV website for more details.

- b. In case of admission of children in class-II and above ( except class XI), fresh registration start only if vacancies are available and thereafter admission test and other formalities should be completed immediately following the prescribed procedure / time schedule given in Admission Guideline, 2009.
- c. The Principal, in consultation with the Chairman VMC of the KV should ensure that overcrowding in the classes are avoided to sustain / improve the quality of education. Only if infrastructure facilities in the form of additional class rooms are made available by the concerned sponsoring agencies, proposals for additional section be sent to KVS(HQ) latest by 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2009 clearly recording the justifications for such proposals.

The compliance report on the instructions issued by the KVS(HQ) be sent to the undersigned by 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2009.
